



She was a member of First Church of God and valued her time being a choir member and fellowshipping with her church family. She was employed at Micro Switch and Structo for many years, but the job she valued most was being a mother. Lottie loved people and spread her love to everyone. People loved stopping by and visiting with Mama Lottie; although, part of the reason may have been her perfect fried chicken! Lottie's laugh and hospitality were second to none.

#### Jim Jeffrey

Raised on a farm in Galena, IL, Jim Jeffrey learned the value of hard work and creative problem solving. After his family moved to Freeport, he attended Freeport Senior High, where he especially enjoyed the industrial arts classes. Jim was a self-taught individual; he later owned a salvage business in Freeport for many years. He also built and raced his own stock cars at Freeport, Wisconsin, and lowa racetracks. #### Elaine Kleindl

Elaine loved working with children and being an educator in the Freeport School District for 26 years. Teaching was not simply a job; it was a lifelong passion which she took very seriously but also made sure her students enjoyed learning. Arnette taught every where she went, and whenever you spoke with her, you left thinking about the conversation you just had. She was an 87-year member of St. James Christian Methodist Episcopal Church where she held several capacities. She loved talking to people, making them laugh, and watching them walk away with a smile.

#### Frank McGee

After moving to Freeport and working for several local businesses, Frank became an entrepreneur and started several of his own businesses including C & C Social Club, Salesman, Frank's Taxicab Service, a Record Shop, and he also operated his own radio show. Frank was well known for his service to the community as a 3rd Ward Alderman and for his work through the NAACP and Freedom of Residence (F.O.R.) Committee. In addition, he was an avid fan of the Freeport Pretzels sports teams and a devoted member of First Church of God where he served for many years as Chairman of the Church Trustee Board and the Pastor's Aide Committee. Better known as Mr. Frank, he was always on the move.

#### Linda Moritz



Don was a farmer for all but two of his ninety-five years. Those two years not on the farm were spent in the US Army Air Corps. He was proud of the Registered Polled Herefords herd he ran for seventy plus years, selling breeding stock, occasional 4H calves, and mentoring several young farmers on starting their own herds. Outside of farming, Don loved sports, golf, playing pitch, the lowa Hawkeyes, and taking time to attend his sons' many sports and activities. He also was fortunate enough to see his grandkids and great grandkids participate in their many activities.
